Ideally, this would create a festival atmosphere across the four School Sport ACT regions (on four separate days). CNSW/ACT could support the day by floating between all events to promote and pump them up. The winners (boys and girls) of all intra-school cups would then qualify to represent their school at the regional inter-school competition in early Term 4 should your school wish to be involved in the day.

This would encourage greater and more diverse participation; and would mean the school would only be able to enter the winning team/s (and students) based on the qualification process at the regional day. This is designed to give an opportunity to and encourage students who have never played the game to engage with cricket..
