SC-ORE is for teams of 2 girls and 2 boys. Teams can register incrementally - that is, register your child, then encourage friends to sign up. Not all team members need to sign up at the same time. If your team is a member short, we will try to find a "spare" to compete your team.

Parents and carers are responsible for completing their child/children's entries online. There is no expectation on schools or teachers to organise any aspect of students' attendance. Parents or responsible guardians have duty of care including the responsibility to bring the children to and from the venues. (Car pooling is recommended.) The children are expected to be at the venue at 7:45am for briefing and an 8am start. Events will finish in time for children to get to school (more or less on time).

The RPL component records 1) current qualifications in emergency care and cardio-pulmonary resuscitation such as Provide CPR or higher levels such as Provide First Aid from an accredited provider and 2) Record of completion of a 400m pool swim in less than 9 minutes. This Registration/RPL Form needs to be completed, signed and submitted at the commencement of the SSSA Course. You will then only need to complete the one page Theory Paper before commencing the practical components.
