Tenpin Bowling Australia

Tenpin Bowling Australia has introduced the Virtual Tenpin Schools Championship for schools, an initiative designed to engage more students to the sport of tenpin bowling. Open to all primary, secondary and disability schools across Australia, this competition offers a fun and inclusive nationwide competition in Term one and two. The competition runs from March 11 through to June 28, allowing schools to compete in individual, doubles, and school-wide categories (the school that knocks down the most pins at their local bowling centre).

Register Your School: The registration fee is \$50 per school, granting unlimited participation throughout the competition period. Note: This fee is separate from any extra fees charged by bowling centres for lane use. After registering, connect with your nearest bowling centre to schedule your bowling sessions.
